To: All UAW Local Union Officers

Greetings:

As you are aware, the 2022 UAW International Officer Election (“Election”) will be conducted by secret mail-in ballot in the fall of 2022. The Monitor and the IEB are working together to ensure that all eligible members are able to vote, and as part of that process, we need your assistance in two key areas: (1) updating the LUIS system with current mailing and email addresses for all active and retired UAW members; and (2) ensuring that the voter eligibility status of all members is accurate, in order for their votes to count.

Per the Election Rules, ballot packages are to be distributed starting in **mid-October 2022**, and all UAW members in good standing as of 5 pm EDT on **October 31, 2022**, will be eligible to vote, including members who are part time workers, reinstated members, and retired members. The UAW’s Election Vendor, **Merriman River Group** (“MRG”), will manage the distribution, collection, and tabulation of ballots, and will facilitate all campaign mailings (postal or email) from the Candidates using the UAW’s Global Mailing List. If you see the MRG name on mail or email correspondence, please be advised that they are contacting you in connection with the Election.

As the Global Mailing List will be created using the most recent addresses on file in LUIS, it is critical that LUIS contains up-to-date mailing and email addresses for all UAW members, as well as accurate information regarding the voter eligibility status of each member. **It is the responsibility of the Local Unions to make sure that its members’ addresses and eligibility status are updated and accurate on the LUIS system immediately. UAW along with MRG will be reaching out to your Local Unions to assist with updating your membership lists.**

Accordingly, we are asking Local Union leadership to do the following:

- Strongly encourage the membership of your Local Union to provide updated mailing and e-mail address information to the Local **as soon as possible**.

- Ensure that LUIS is updated with any new or updated member mailing and/or e-mail address information as soon as the information is received by your Local Union, but **no later** than the following deadlines each month:
  - July 29, 2022
  - August 26, 2022
  - September 16, 2022
  - October 7, 2022
  - October 18, 2022
  - November 11, 2022
- Ensure that LUIS is updated with the current voter eligibility status of each member. More information will be provided separately on how to update this information, but it should be updated by each of the first five deadlines above, and then again with final status no later than October 31, 2022.

We appreciate your help in this very important effort.

We are also attaching a copy of the **Notice of the 2022 UAW International Officer Election**. We ask that Local Union leaders post this Notice to your Local Union websites and social media (or alternatively, link to the UAW's or Monitor's website regarding the Election, both of which post the Notice<sup>1</sup>), and also post physical copies of the Notice wherever appropriate (i.e., official union bulletin boards, jobsites, meeting halls, etc.). We also ask that you **e-mail the Notice** to all members of your Local Union with email addresses you have on file.
