The Local Union Bargaining Committee will assign your strike activity. Participation may be picket duty, kitchen duty or other strike related assignments. You **MUST** be a member in good standing (including supplementals) **AND** participate in strike activities at the time of the strike in order to receive benefits.

- It is your obligation to check for the time and date of your strike assignment. Assignments will be posted on bulletin boards at: 29781 Oregon Rd., Perrysburg, OH 43551 and/or at www.uawlocal1435.org
- In order to qualify for your first strike assistance check, you must register at your designated time (TBD). You will need to bring the following with you: smart phone, social security numbers for spouse and all dependent children, birthdates, picture ID, bank account number, routing number and current medical coverage. All strike pay will be in an ACH deposit directly to your account. Strike pay is taxable income but no taxes will be withheld. You will receive a 1099 at the end of the year.
- When you register for assistance you will be issued a picket card and your picket captain will indicate on the card when you have completed your strike duty. You **MUST** sign in when reporting for picket duty and it's imperative you do not lose your picket card

Any member eligible for strike assistance preceding the termination of the strike will receive a back to work check. You are to report to UAW Local 1435 Union Hall, 29781 Oregon Rd., Perrysburg, OH 43551 at your posted strike time.

In case of a strike, you will be instructed by management how to shut down your machinery to avoid any damage to company property and exit the plant in an orderly dignified manner.

DO NOT take action to strike unless your Bargaining Chair or his Committee directly notifies you.
